

NEWSLETTER

With OppiPanne only 8 weeks away, we wanted to ensure that you guys are up to date with all planning, arrangements and have sufficient information to make informed decisions.

The festival format will work as follows:

Thursday 8 Aug: The festival area will open at 15:00, all tents (Beer, wine & Gin) will be open, alongside the two restaurants, coffee shop, activities and all other suppliers.

From 17:00 there will be a massive beer tent music evening, hiding a few surprises... The bar and festival area closes at 00:00

Friday 9 Aug: The festival area will be open form 08:00 for breakfast, coffee and activities. The music will start early (around 10:30), with a wide range of music shows, highlighted by **Deon Meiring**, **Tasché**, **Zaan Sonnekus**, **Steve Umculo**, **Corrazerwas**, **Die Heuwels Fantasties** and many more..

Saturday 10 Aug: A full last day kicks off at 07:00 in the beer tent with the Springboks vs Aus on the big screen, followed by the local marimbas, consisting of school kids from the greater MAUN area. Music shows in the beer tent will continue until 14:30, before moving to the Main stage at 16:30 for the final evening, highlighted by Liza Nel, Herman Kleinhans, Die Piesagskille, Ricus Nel and Juan Boucher.

The party will continue in the beer tent until 00:00.

TICKETS:

Please ensure that you print each ticket, to be scanned at the festival entrance to get your matching wristband for your festival entry.

No one will be allowed in the festival area without their wristband.

*A festival ticket includes self camping in the allocated camping area



IMPORTANT INFORMATION



SELF CAMPING: Each ticket holder is entitled to self camp in the allocated camping area (don't stress, it is a massive demarcated area).

- The festival provides an ablution (toilets and hot showers) facility, allocated in a centralised area.
- Please consider other guests and the environment by taking short showers, once a day. *Remember we have to remove all water and waste from the festival zone.
- Please don't NO2 in the field area around your own camp...
- All solar solutions for electricity will be welcomed, but we regret that no generators are allowed, noise and environmental impact being the restrictions.
- **PLEASE** bring a braai or ground plate for fires, each camp area needs to be in the same condition when you depart.
- Don't leave your surplus wood, broken equipment or rubbish behind.
- Please consider other guests with noise

BIKES & E-BIKES



No bikes will be allowed at the festival this year (this includes festival management), the additional dust and safety concern is to much of a liability to the outcome of the festival.

The local **POLICE** will be in control of this.

DIRECTIONS:

The festival is located approximately 29km South West of Nata. From Nata, head West on the A3 to Maun, 10km outside Nata, you will see an OPPIPANNE turnoff, heading South. There will be direction boards placed along the 19km two-track all the way to the festival.

1km from the festival there will be a gate to check and scan your tickets (for your wrist bands) and will direct you to the self camping area.

*Other alternative routes have been closed.

WOOD: There will be a wood station allocated in NATA town, it will be close to the Engen garage, where the local community will also sell curios and arts & crafts.

Thursday. Drinking water will also be available at the festival area.



MEAT: The meat vendor will also be located in the festival area and available from Thursday 15:00

*South African guests, please remember that you can't bring your own meat through the border.





WIFI & Cellphone reception: There will be no WIFI available as no system can accommodate 2500+ guests without congestion and crashing.

We advise all guests to get a MASCOM simcard on their way to the festival, Palapye & Francistown are best located to stop. *Mascom is the only network that has 4G at the festival





Medical: As with previous years, we will have medical staff stationed at the festival area, but guests are advised to bring a MEDICAL kit along with essential medicine. Check with your medical aid about cross cover, alternatively please look at http://www.okavangorescue.com/patronage.php for a cover option.


